He is a graduate of the Queensland Conservatorium of Music where he gained his Bachelor's Degree in Violin. Bruce has been on the staff of the Queensland Conservatorium Music School (now Young Conservatorium) and has extensive experience in teaching pre-tertiary programs

Bruce has been Director of Music for the Gold Coast Youth Orchestra since 1988. As a result of this work in 2002, he was nominated and short-listed for the "national regional award given to an individual who has fostered excellence, innovation and/or creativity in an Orchestra in a regional area." He is a member of the Music Arrangers Guild of Australia and has prepared music for the Symphony Australia Orchestras, movies and television. Prominent Australian composers including Brian May, Richard Mills, Vincent Plush, Colin Brumby, Andrew Schultz and Felix Meagher, have used his work in premieres in Australia and the United States.

Bruce was part of the Queensland Youth Orchestra program for 12 years including 3 years in the Queensland Youth Symphony under maestro Dr John Curro.

In the past year, he has been a guest clinician for the PMSA Symphony Orchestra, the Sunshine Coast Honours Wind Ensemble, and the State Honours Ensemble Program among others.
