Choir Conductor

Trisha Matthias graduated from Queensland University with a Bachelor of Music (Honours) Degree in 1984. During that time, she studied Pipe Organ, Singing and Piano and was awarded the J. Albert and Sons Prize for showing the greatest proficiency in Principal Study (Pipe Organ) and the Carl and Ruth Neilson Bursary for cultural achievements.

She was appointed to the staff of Brisbane Girls' Grammar School in 1985 where she became Coordinator of Classroom and Choral Music in 1988. She was awarded a Queen Elizabeth II Silver Jubilee Trust for Young Australians grant to attend the 1989 Summer Session at Westminster Choir College, Princeton, New Jersey USA.

In her role as Music Editor (1994-1999) of Together in Song (Australian Hymnbook Company), Trisha worked to promote the Hymn Book at launches, workshops and through the media. In addition to this, she produced the 66 track CD recording Together in Song, to accompany the release of the Hymn Book.

Trisha was appointed to the staff of The Southport School in April 2005. As Music Master, Trisha has worked to promote music in the School as an important and valued activity to be undertaken. To be able to play a part in nurturing the boys in music is very rewarding and special. She successfully directed the 2012 and 2016 Band of Brothers' Tour and more recently the Outback Music Tour of Goondiwindi in 2015.

Domenica Kelly was born in Tasmania, where she completed her Bachelor of Music, majoring in performance, at the Conservatorium of Tasmania. She was a member of the Australian Youth Orchestra, and toured all over Europe before moving to Brisbane. In Brisbane she worked with the Queensland Symphony Orchestra, the Queensland Philharmonic Orchestra and Pops Orchestra. She was also for many years a theatre musician, working with renowned international artists and stage productions.

Domenica is passionate about music education, and in 1995 completed her Graduate Diploma of Education. She has taught violin and viola in Catholic boy's schools in Brisbane for over 20 years. Domenica holds the position of the Director of Strings at St Joseph's College Gregory Terrace, a position she has enjoyed for many years.


In the role of Director of Culture, Vicki had the responsibility of overseeing all co-curricular activities outside the classroom that was not sport related.
